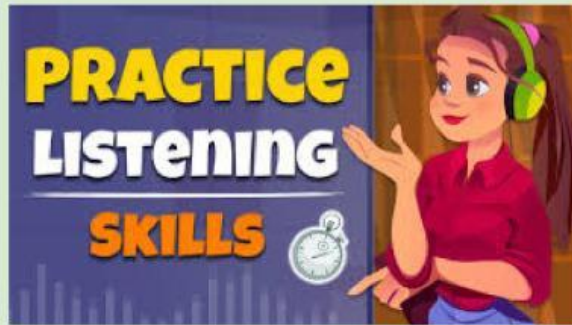




LISTENING 1: TALKING ABOUT THE SEASONS
