

Vocabulary: Prefixes

- A **prefix** is a word part added to the **beginning** of a word.
- A prefix changes the **meaning** of a word.

Prefix	Meaning	Example
<i>un-</i>	<i>not, the opposite of</i>	<i>un + tie = untie</i>
<i>re-</i>	<i>again, back</i>	<i>re + read = reread</i>
