"The pitcher is too tall!" says Crow. "What can I do?"

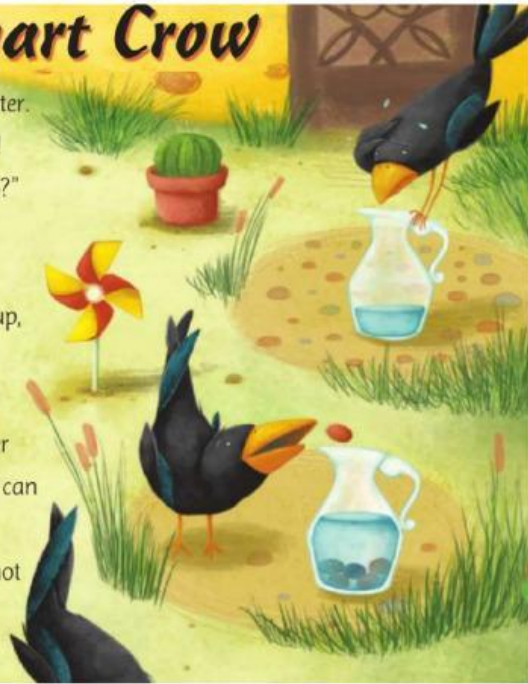
Crow thinks about it.
