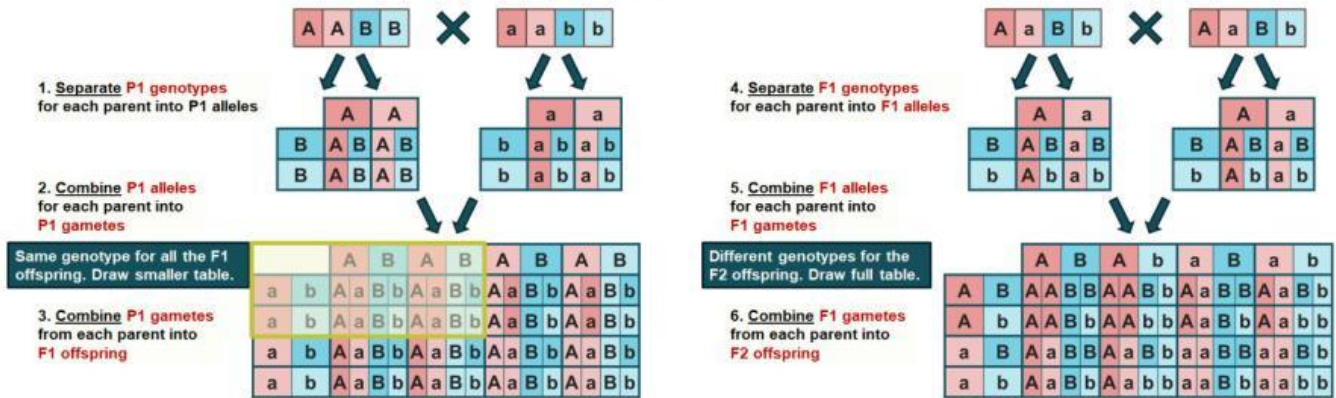


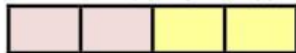


Mendel's Rule of segregation: 2. Dihybrid Cross

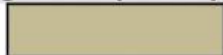

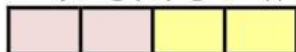

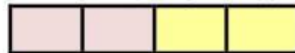
F₁ gametes: dominant alleles

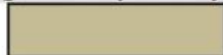

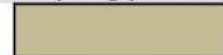

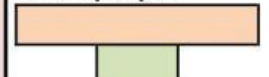


F₁ offspring phenotype

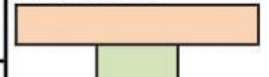


F₂ genotypes and phenotype ratio

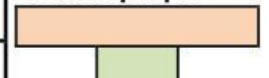
1. tall purple
