Three places to learn surfing



Nosara, Costa Rica

From the centre of the town of Nosara, you can easily walk to several good beaches for beginner surfers. The sea is warm all year round and the weather is beautiful, so you'll be surprised by how quiet the beaches always are. There are many excellent surf teachers around the town, and their prices aren't high. The town's also famous for its wildlife park, where you can see some amazing sea animals.

Agadir, Morocco

The area around Agadir in the south of Morocco is very popular with surfers. Beginners need to go in autumn when the sea is safe and the water is nice and warm. However, Zed Layson, a famous surfer, has a school there at Surfer's Point, which is excellent for those who want to try the sport for the first time. As well as good teachers, there is always a photographer waiting to take a picture of you on your surfboard. In summer it rains a lot, but the water is warm so surfing is still possible.
