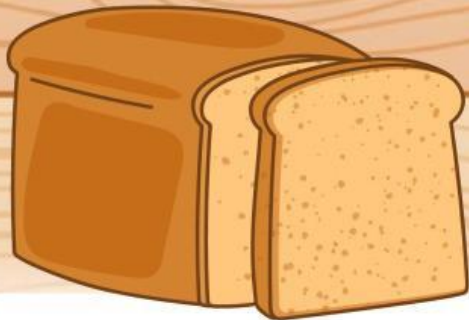
# FOOD

# LIKES and DISLIKES

**I LIKE...**

**Pattern:** I like + food/drink

**Examples:**

- I like chicken.
- I like orange juice.
- I like noodles very much.



# LIKES and DISLIKES

**I DON'T LIKE...**

**Pattern:** I don't like + food/drink

**Examples:**

- I don't like coffee.
- I don't like fish.



# ASKING QUESTIONS

## DO YOU LIKE...?

### Pattern:

Do you like + food/drink?

### Answers:

● Yes, I do.



● No, I don't.



### Example Dialogue:

A: Do you like milk?

B: Yes, I do.

A: Do you like coffee?

B: No, I don't.



# ORDERING FOOD

*Cafe*

## Polite Expressions:

1. I would like..., please.
2. May I have..., please?
3. Can I get..., please?



## Examples:

- I would like chicken soup, please.
- May I have a glass of milk, please?
- Can I get a bowl of noodles, please?



## Don't say:

- Give me chicken!
- I want milk!

**Waiter:**

Good afternoon. What would you like to order?

**Customer:**

I would like a plate of rice and chicken, please.



**Waiter:**

And what would you like to drink?

**Customer:**

A glass of orange juice, please.



**Waiter:**

Sure. Please wait a moment.

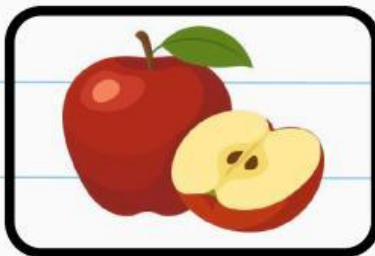
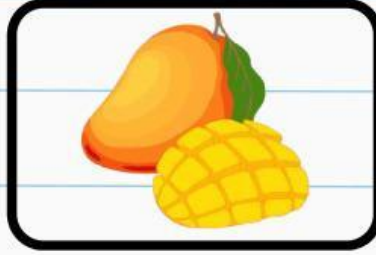
