Write a short paragraph (6–8 lines) using will, going to, and would.

You must talk about your future plans, a prediction, and an imaginary situation.

Follow these instructions:

Use at least one sentence with “going to” to describe a real plan you already decided.

Use at least one sentence with “will” to express a prediction or a quick decision.

Use at least one sentence with “would” to describe an unreal or imaginary situation.

Check grammar, capitalization, and spelling before submitting.

Make sure your ideas are clear and connected.

Add a title to your paragraph.

Example structure (don’t copy):

- My real plan... (going to)
- A prediction... (will)
- An imaginary idea... (would)
