****Reading: Animals in the Future****

Scientists believe that animals will face many changes in the next fifty years. Some species will adapt to new environments, while others are going to move to different areas to survive.

For example, polar bears will experience warmer temperatures, so they are going to search for food in new regions. Many birds will also migrate earlier because the weather will change faster than before. In the Amazon rainforest, some animals are going to develop new behaviors to live with less water, while others will find new ways to communicate.

Experts say that humans will create more protected areas to help animals, but we are also going to need stronger laws to protect endangered species. If people work together, many animal populations will recover in the future.
