Passive Voice

Formula

Passive = Be + V3 (past participle)

What is Passive voice

Passive voice is a sentence form where the subject receives the action, not performs it.

Passive Voice Formula

	Simple to be V3	Continuous to be being V3	Perfect to be been V3
Present	am } is } V3 are }	am } is } Being V3 are }	Have } Has } Been V3
Past	Was } Were } V3	Was } Were } Being V3	Had } } Been V3
Future	Shall } Will } Be V3	---	Will Have Been V3
