


Respiratory System

3. _____ bronchi	C. hairlike structures that line the mucous membranes and remove trapped particles from the nostrils
4. _____ trachea	D. a dome-shaped muscle between the thorax and abdomen which contracts and expands to allow for breathing
5. _____ alveoli	E. tiny tubes for the passage of air that branch off the bronchi like tree limbs
6. _____ bronchioles	F. the two main branches of the trachea that lead to each lung
7. _____ thorax	G. another name for the trachea
8. _____ larynx	H. thin-walled tube that extends from the larynx to the bronchi, carrying air to the lungs
9. _____ windpipe	I. the region of the human body that extends from the neck to the diaphragm
10. _____ cilia	J. the unit of bones that protects the thorax
