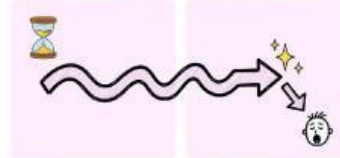
I

Past Perfect Continuous – Use



We use the Past Perfect Continuous to talk about an action that started in the past and continued for some time before another action in the past.

Duration before a past moment



It is the past equivalent of the Present Perfect Continuous.

The Past Perfect Continuous emphasizes how long an action had been happening before something else happened in the past.

Past Perfect Continuous вживається, щоб показати дію, яка почалася в минулому і тривала певний час до іншої дії в минулому.

Тривалість дії до певного моменту в минулому

Цей час є минулим відповідником Present Perfect Continuous і підкреслює тривалість дії перед іншою минулою подією.

Приклад:



- He had been waiting for the bus for half an hour before it came.
- (Очікування тривало деякий час і закінчилося до іншої дії в минулому.)

Past Perfect Continuous – Use



Visible result in the past

We also use the Past Perfect Continuous when the result of an action was evident at a specific moment in the past.

Помітний результат у минулому

Past Perfect Continuous також вживається, коли результат дії був помітний у минулому.

Приклад:

- She was tired. She had been working hard all day yesterday.
- (Втома була очевидною саме в той момент у минулому.)



Time Expressions (Past Perfect Continuous)



for — протягом (періоду часу)

☞ використовується з тривалістю

Example: for two hours, for a long time

since — з (певного моменту в минулому)

☞ показує початкову точку дії

Example: since morning, since 2018

how long — як довго

☞ ставиться у запитаннях про тривалість дії

Example: How long had you been waiting?

before — перед тим як / до того як

☞ показує, що одна дія відбулася раніше за іншу

Example: before she arrived

until / till — до (певного моменту)

☞ показує, до якого часу тривала дія

Example: until midnight
