He wrote about six hundred songs in all. Among his best songs are Noi vong tay lon (Circle of Unity), Ha trang (White Summer) and Cat Bui (Dust). His songs are **mostly** about love, human condition, and nature. He died in Ho Chi Minh City in 2001. His songs remain popular among the Vietnamese all over the world today. Many have been translated into English, French, Japanese, and other languages.
