DUNE: PART ONE

FILM REVIEW

Dune: Part One is a science-fiction film directed by Denis Villeneuve. Timothée Chalamet plays the leading role of Paul Atreides, the son of Duke Leto Atreides (played by Oscar Isaac), who is the leader of planet Caladan.

The film is set on the dangerous planet of Arrakis, in the year 10,191. Arrakis is the only planet in space that makes 'spice', a rare material. Emperor Shaddam IV, the most powerful emperor in space, lets Duke Leto control Arrakis. The Duke, Paul, and the Atreides soldiers travel to Arrakis. There, Paul sees Baron Vladimir Harkonnen (played by Stellan Skarsgård),

who wants to destroy the Atreides family. A great battle between the Atreides and the Harkonnen armies starts. Will Paul use his secret powers to help win the battle? What will happen if he does?

In my opinion, *Dune* is an exciting film with lots of action-packed scenes. The special effects are amazing, and the plot is quite interesting. All the actors are very talented. I recommend this film to all science-fiction film fans. You shouldn't miss it for the world!
