

Describing places

THERE IS/THERE ARE

There is: is used for **one** place or thing.

There are: is used for **two or more** places or things.

Example: **there is** a bank on Main Street/ **there are** two restaurants near the park.



Prepositions of place: Prepositions of place are used to say where a person, place, or thing is.

next to: The bank is next to the school.

near/close to: There is mall near my house

across from: There is a café across from the library

in front of: There is a bus stop in front of the mall

behind: the school is behind the church

between: The bank is between the post office and the café.

on the corner of: The store is on the corner of Main Street.



Quantifiers: They are words used to talk about the **quantity or how many or how much** of something there is.

some: used with **plural nouns** in **affirmative** sentences: There are some restaurants on this street.

any: used with **plural/uncountable** nouns in **questions** and **negative** sentences: Are there any supermarkets near here?

many: used with **plural countable** nouns (usually in questions and negatives): There aren't many cafés here.

much: used with **uncountable nouns** (usually in questions and negatives): Is there much traffic in this area?

few: used with **plural countable** nouns to say "not many"/There are few buses at night.

little: used with **uncountable** nouns to say "not much"/ There is little water in the park fountain.
