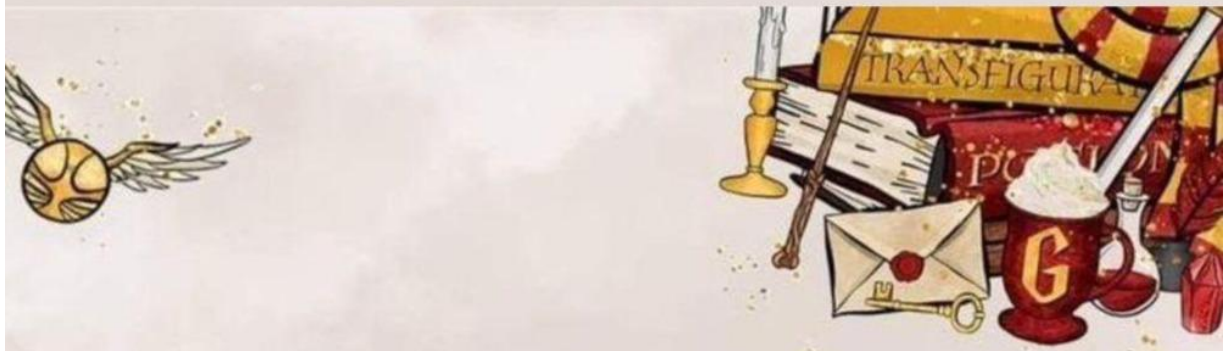
Discussion questions (kids-friendly):
