

Write each number in normal form.

Example: $1.792 = 1 \times 1 + 7 \times 0.1 + 9 \times 0.01 + 2 \times 0.001$

$$= 1 \times 1 + 7 \times 0.01 + 9 \times 0.001$$

$$= 2 \times 1 + 1 \times 0.1 + 8 \times 0.01 + 1 \times 0.001$$

$$= 3 \times 1 + 2 \times 0.1 + 5 \times 0.01$$

$$= 1 \times 1 + 2 \times 0.01 + 8 \times 0.001$$

$$= 8 \times 1 + 8 \times 0.1$$

$$= 7 \times 1 + 2 \times 0.01 + 2 \times 0.001$$

$$= 9 \times 1 + 4 \times 0.1 + 1 \times 0.001$$

$$= 1 \times 1 + 5 \times 0.01 + 5 \times 0.001$$

$$= 5 \times 1 + 6 \times 0.001$$

$$= 5 \times 1 + 5 \times 0.1$$

$$= 1 \times 1 + 1 \times 0.1 + 2 \times 0.001$$

$$= 9 \times 1 + 2 \times 0.1 + 4 \times 0.01$$

$$= 3 \times 1 + 2 \times 0.1 + 4 \times 0.01$$

$$= 2 \times 18 \times 0.1 + 9 \times 0.01 + 8 \times 0.001$$
