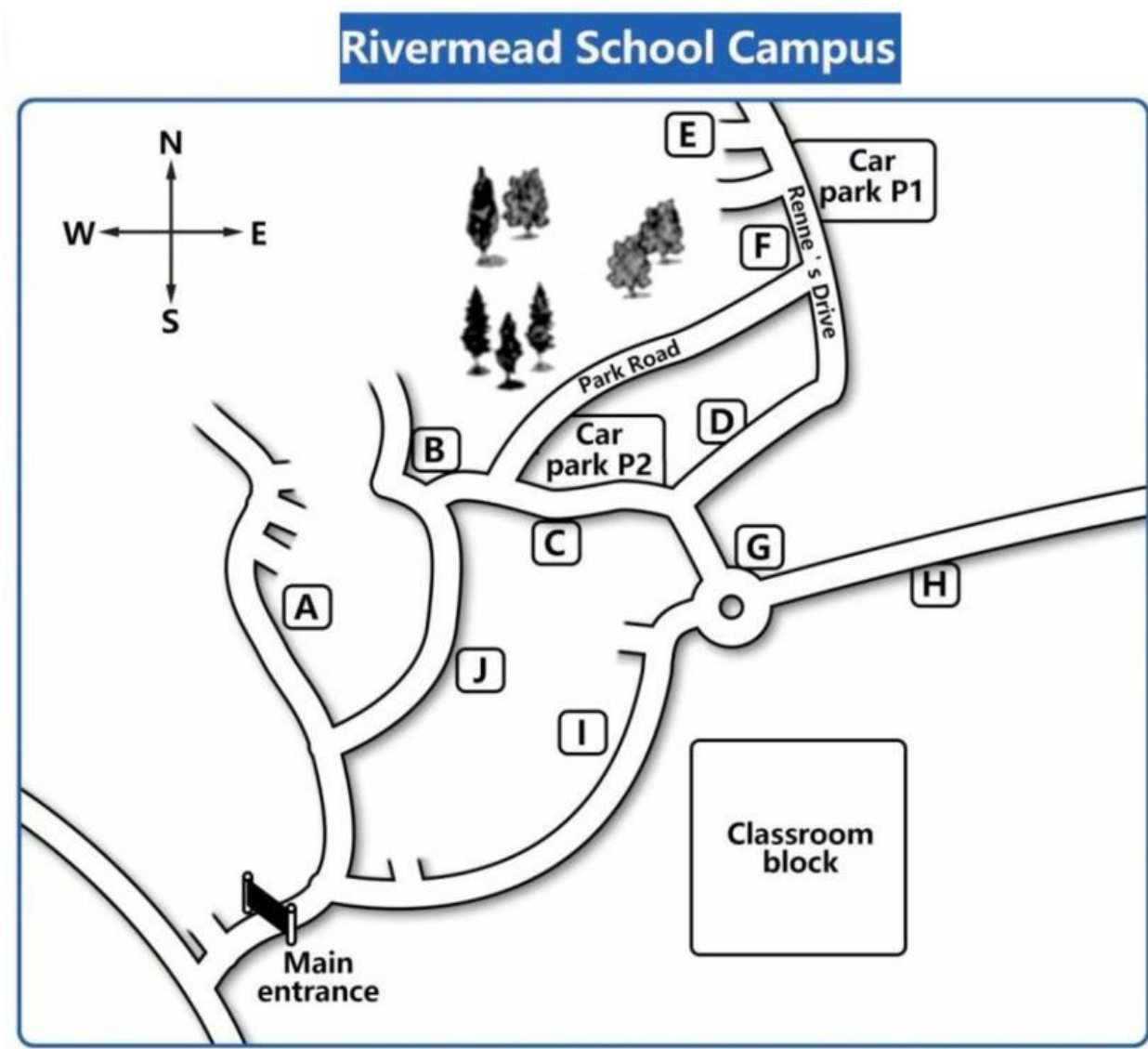

Office Design

Early 20th Century
