### SET B – Online Gambling Should Be TOTALLY BANNED

<b>CLAIM</b> Which side of the issue do you believe in?	
<b>ARGUMENT</b> Give statements to support your claim.	
<b>EVIDENCE</b> Give facts, statistics, or concrete examples that support the argument.	
<b>COUNTER-ARGUMENT</b> Recognize the opposite side. (What might someone say if they disagreed with you?)	
<b>REBUTTAL</b> Defend your claim against the counterargument. (What would you say to the person who disagreed with you to change their mind?)	
<b>CONCLUSION</b> Give a convincing restatement of the original claim.	

<b>Sentence 1</b>	Even with regulation, people remain vulnerable, and banning online gambling entirely removes temptation and reduces harmful behaviors.
<b>Sentence 2</b>	A survey in Southeast Asia reports that nearly 6 in 10 online gamblers fall into debt within their first year.
<b>Sentence 3</b>	Online gambling causes addiction, financial problems, and mental stress for many users.
<b>Sentence 4</b>	While some argue that regulating gambling platforms could control the problem, others believe it still poses danger.
<b>Sentence 5</b>	Therefore, a total ban is the most effective approach to protect citizens from addiction, debt, and long-term social harm.
<b>Sentence 6</b>	Online gambling should be completely banned because its risks to individuals and society outweigh any potential benefits.
