

Dolphins are very intelligent because they understand and learn quickly. Scientists say dolphins and human's intelligence are similar in some ways, for example: dolphins have a complex language that they use to hunt. It is a combination of clicks and sounds. Many scientists think that each dolphin has its own distinctive sound that differentiates it from the others. Dolphins, like men, are social animals. Dolphins raise their babies

together and live in groups called "pods" or "schools". They also travel in groups. Other interesting facts about dolphins are: they can stay underwater for more than fifteen minutes without breathing; they can also locate objects using sounds likeradar. This is called "echolocation" and they use it to find and identify other sea animals and objects effectively. When dolphins sleep, only one of their eyes is closed because half of their brain stays awake.

Scientists are always trying to understand dolphins because their mysterious behavior has many things to tell us about the life deep under the sea.


