

Prepositions of Place (City Places)

IN

We use **IN** for places **inside** an area.

Example: The café is in the city.

ON

We use **ON** for streets and avenues.

Example: The hotel is on Main Street.

NEXT TO

NEXT TO means **very near**.

Example: The bank is next to the supermarket.

NEAR

NEAR means **not far**.

Example: The hospital is near the mall.

BETWEEN

BETWEEN means in the **middle of two** places.

Example: The café is between the bank and the library.

OPPOSITE / ACROSS FROM

OPPOSITE or **ACROSS FROM** means **facing another place**.

Example: The bank is across from the school.

IN FRONT OF

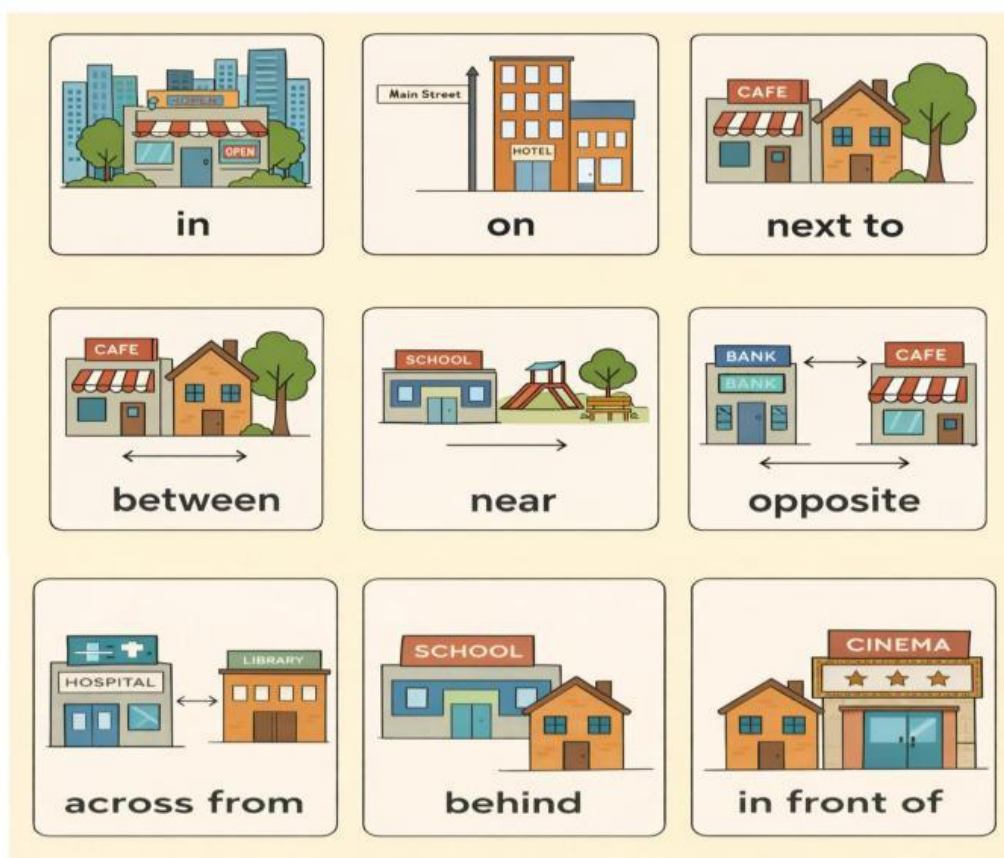
IN FRONT OF means **before another place**.

Example: The house is in front of the cinema.

BEHIND

BEHIND means **at the back of** another place.

Example: The house is behind the school.
