

EJERCICIO – IR / LLEGAR / VENIR

To go, to come, to arrive

- ◆ **IR** → movement away from where you are
- ◆ **VENIR** → movement towards where you are
- ◆ **LLEGAR** → focus on the moment of arrival

VERB TENSES:

- ✓ Pretérito perfecto compuesto → he, has, ha, hemos habéis, han + ado/ido
- ✓ Futuro: ir a + infinitivo → voy, vas, va, vamos, vais, van a + v. AR, ER, IR;

(British English: Have you gone to Madrid today?)

-  *Someone is coming to your house this evening.*

Esta tarde _____ a mi casa.

(British English: This evening they're going to come to my house.)

-  *Your partner is not here yet.*

Español:

Mi pareja no _____ todavía.

(British English: My partner hasn't arrived yet.)

📌 *You are inviting someone to your city next weekend.*

Español:

El próximo fin de semana ____ a mi ciudad.

(British English: Next weekend they're going to come to my city.)

Contexto

📌 *You are talking about a trip you made recently.*

Español:

Esta semana ____ al sur de España.

(British English: This week I've been to the south of Spain.)

Contexto

📌 *Someone has returned and is now here.*

Español:

Ya ____ del trabajo.

(British English: They've already arrived back from work.)

Contexto

📌 *You are asking if someone has come to the office today.*

Español:

¿Hoy ____ a la oficina?

(British English: Have you come to the office today?)

Contexto

📌 *You are talking about a plan to travel somewhere.*

Español:

Mañana ____ al médico.

(British English: Tomorrow I'm going to go to the doctor.)

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📌 *You are happy because someone visited you recently.*

Español:

Mis padres ____ a verme esta semana.

(British English: My parents have come to see me this week.)
