

Listen and draw lines. There is one example.

Lines should be drawn between:

1. Grace and the girl reading under the tree
2. Dan and the boy waving and holding a bat
3. Alex and the boy skateboarding
4. Eva and the girl with purple boots, flying a kite
5. Alice and the girl with black hair, playing a board game

Example

Boy: Look! My friends are in the park.

Woman: That's nice!

Boy: Yes. Alex loves skateboarding!

Woman: I know.

Boy: Can you see Eva?

Is she the one with the kite?

Boy: Yes, she is.

Woman: I like Eva's purple boots. They're beautiful!

Woman: Who's that girl with the long black hair at the table?

Boy: At the table? That's my friend Alice.

Woman: Does Alice enjoy playing board games?

Boy: Yes, she does.
