A cheetah is faster **er than** a mouse.
The Pacific Ocean is wider **er than** the Atlantic Ocean.
Grapes are smaller **er than** melons.
Is an ocean deeper **er than** a lake? Yes, it is.
Is a cheetah slower **er than** a lion? No, it isn't.
Are trees taller **er than** flowers? Yes, they are.
Are cats faster **er than** horses? No, they aren't.

We use **-er than** to talk about a difference between two things.
