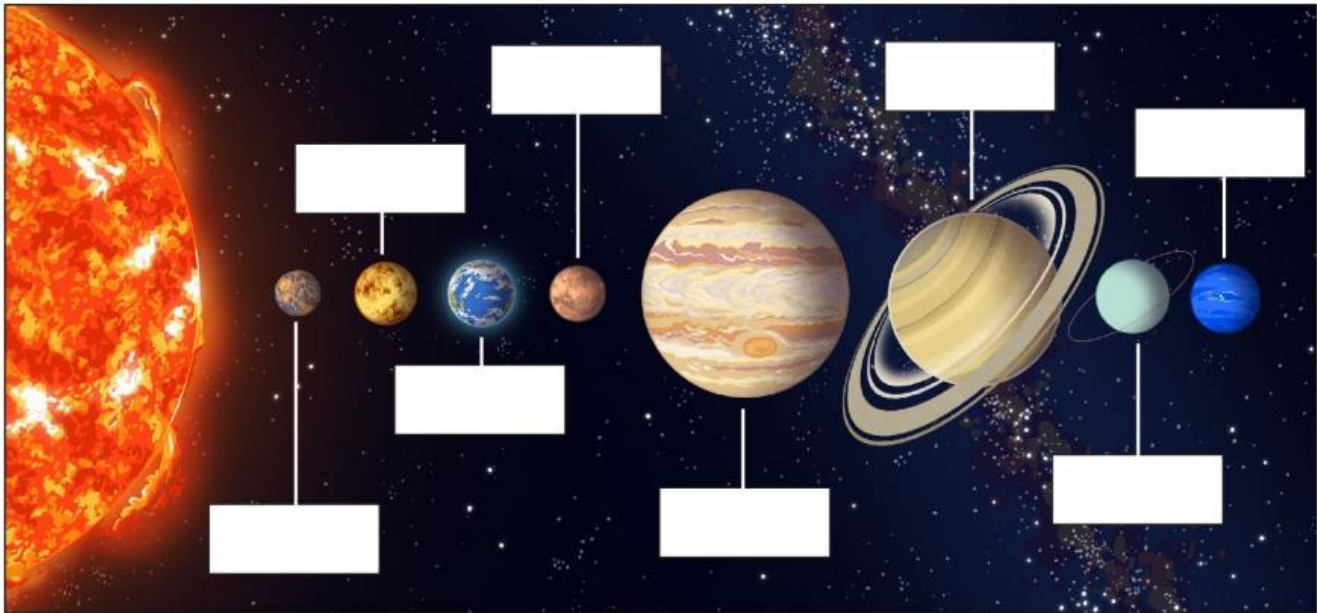


The Solar System
