Past

Simple:	Continuous:
+ Ved/V2: <i>I played basketball <u>yesterday</u>.</i> <i>He went to school two days <u>ago</u>.</i>	To be + Ving <i>I was reading <u>at that moment</u>.</i> <i>They were watching TV.</i>
- Did: <i>I didn't play <u>tennis yesterday</u>.</i> <i>He didn't go to the cinema two days <u>ago</u>.</i>	- <i>I was not cooking the <u>whole</u> evening.</i> <i>They were not doing their homework.</i>
