

10. The order of events based on time sequence.
13. The grammatical tense used to describe completed actions in stories.
18. The part of the story that introduces characters, place, and time.
19. The most exciting part or the peak of the conflict in a story.
20. A narrative about the origin of a place or a person, often based on history.
21. A word used to describe the qualities of characters or settings.

1. The perspective from which the story is told (1st or 3rd person).
2. An optional part that contains a moral lesson from the story.
3. A word that describes how, when, or where an action happens (e.g., happily).
5. Words like 'then', 'after that', or 'meanwhile' to connect events.
7. The part where the main character faces a problem or crisis.
11. The information about where and when the story takes place.
12. The struggle or struggle between opposing forces in a plot.
14. Verbs that show physical activity, like 'ran', 'fought', or 'jumped'.
15. The character who opposes or causes conflict for the hero.
16. The main character, often the hero of the narrative.
