We use comparative adjectives to describe people . animals and things.

We use comparatives to compare things . Add '-er' ' for one syllable adjectives or just "-r" if the adjective finish in vowel. small – smaller large - larger

Add '-er' for adjectives which end in consonant-vowel-

consonant and double the last consonant. big - bigger


Add '-ier' for two syllable adjectives which end in 'y' (and take away the 'y')

two syllables with 'y': happy - happier heavy -heavier

The adjectives 'good' and 'bad' have special forms.

good - better

bad - worse
