- **Les Articles Définis (The):** Le (m), La (f), L' (vowel), Les (plural).
- **Les Articles Indéfinis (A/Some):** Un (m), Une (f), Des (plural).
- **Les Saisons:** Le printemps (Spring), L'été (Summer), L'automne (Autumn), L'hiver (Winter).
- **Les Pays:** Most ending in **-e** are Feminine (**La** France). Others are Masculine (**Le** Japon). Always use **L'** for vowel starts (**L'Inde).
- **Les Nombres (60-70):** 60 is **Soixante**. To get to 70, we say **Soixante-dix** (60+10).
