Today's college students may not simply sit in a lecture or a library to learn about their field. Through their computers and the wonders of virtual reality, **they** can participate in lifelike simulated experiences. Consider the following **scenario** of the future of education made possible through developments in information technology.

For children over the age of 10, daily attendance at schools is not compulsory. Yet, some of the older children attend school only once or twice weekly to get tutorial support or instruction from a teacher. For the most part, pupils are encouraged to work online from home. Students must complete a **minimum** number of study hours per year; however, they may make up these hours by studying at home at times that suit their family schedule.
