

Naaman is Healed - QUIZ 1

2 Kings 5

- Who was Naaman?
 - King Aram's son
 - Commander of King Aram's army
 - King of Israel at the time
- What ailment did Naaman suffer from?
 - The plague
 - Scarlet Fever
 - Leprosy
- What did Naaman's wife's maid suggest for Naaman to do?
 - Bath in the Jordan River
 - Repent for his sins
 - Go see the prophet in Samaria who could heal his leprosy
- What did Naaman carry with him as gifts to the King of Israel?
 - 700 donkeys, 40 lbs of silver, and 50 lbs of gold
 - 750 lbs of silver, 150 lbs of gold and 10 sets of clothing
 - 200 goats, 300 sheep, and 500 lbs of gold
- What did the prophet Elisha say to the King when he tore his clothes in dismay?
 - That he could heal Naaman
 - That Naaman was going to die of leprosy
 - To bring Naaman to him (Elisha) so that he could see there was a true prophet in Israel
- What did Elisha tell Naaman to do?
 - Wash himself 7 times in the Jordan River to be healed
 - Wave his hand twice before him
 - Go back to Samaria
- Why was Naaman angry with Elisha when he told him to go wash in the Jordan River?
 - He thought his instructions were too easy
 - He expected him to heal him with a wave of his hand
 - Both a and b
- Because Naaman was angry, did he do as he was instructed (to wash himself in the Jordan River)?
 - Yes
 - No
- What was the result of Naaman bathing in the Jordan River?
 - His skin became healthy and he was healed
 - His skin turned red and his infection got worse
 - His skin was burned and he died from his wounds
- What did Naaman ask of Elisha before he left?
 - To take some of his donkeys back home with him
 - To take some of the earth from Israel back home with him (to remind him that the only true God is the Lord of Israel)
 - To thank the Lord for him
- What did Gehazi do to Naaman after he left?
 - Followed him and told him that Elisha sent him to collect gifts for two young prophets that just arrived
 - He lied and kept the gifts for himself
 - Both a and b
- What did Gehazi do when he returned with the gifts?
 - Gave them to the king
 - Hid them in his house
 - Give them to Elisha
- Did Elisha know that Gehazi lied about the two young prophets needing the gifts?
 - Yes
 - No
- What was Gehazi's punishment (consequence) for lying about the gifts?
 - All of his descendants would die a horrible death at a very young age
 - He would be delivered to the King for heresy
 - Him and his descendants would suffer from leprosy forever
