Present Simple (Green)

USE: habits, routines, facts.

Signal words: always, usually, often, every day.

FORM:

I / You / We / They → base verb (work)

He / She / It → verb + S (works)

NEGATIVE: do not / does not + base verb

She doesn't work. (NO S after doesn't)

Present Continuous (Blue)

USE: happening NOW, temporary actions.

Signal words: now, at the moment, today.

FORM:

am / is / are + verb + ING

I am working.

She is reading.

Spelling:

make → making (drop E)

run → running (double consonant)
