



# EPSTEIN'S FRAMEWORK OF SIX TYPES OF FAMILY INVOLVEMENT

This table presents Joyce Epstein's model describing six key ways families can be involved in children's education. The framework shows that effective education is built on a partnership between school, family, and community, rather than relying only on classroom instruction.

## Key idea:

Parental involvement is not limited to attending meetings; it includes home support, communication, participation, shared decision-making, and community connections. Together, these forms of involvement strengthen student achievement and overall development.

The six types of involvement include:

1. Parenting – Schools support families in creating home environments that help children succeed as students (e.g., parent education, health and social services support).
2. Communicating – Establishing clear, two-way communication between school and home about student progress, programs, and expectations.
3. Volunteering – Recruiting and organizing parents to assist at school, in classrooms, and during school events.
4. Learning at Home – Helping families support academic learning outside school through homework guidance, educational activities, and planning for future goals.
5. Decision Making – Including parents in school leadership and decision-making processes through councils, committees, and parent organizations.
6. Collaborating with the Community – Connecting families with community resources and creating partnerships that support student learning and development.
