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Spelling

Children must learn **all the spelling words** and **both Dictations**.

Rhyming Words

Words that **sound the same** at the end.

day-play cloud-proud cat-mat

Suffixes

A suffix is added to the **end of a word**.

Rule: Copy the base word and add the suffix.

- -ing → jump → jumping
- -ed → help → helped
- -er → fast → faster
- -est → fast → fastest

**Reading comprehension:
Types of Questions:**

1. **Multiple Choice (Literal Questions)**
Answers are directly in the text.
Example: Where did Sam go?
→ Park
2. **Fill in the Blank**
Children find the exact word from the story.
3. **Short Answer (Why/How Questions)**
These require thinking and explaining.
Example: Why was Sam sad?
→ Because it was time to go home.
4. **Opinion Questions**
Children give their own ideas.
Example: Do you like going to the park?
Yes. It is fun/No. It is hot.

Information pack

Plurals

Plural means **more than one**.

Rule 1: Copy the word and add **-s**.

- dog → dogs
- cat → cats

Rule 2: Add **-es** to words ending in **s, x, z, ch, sh**

- bus → buses
- box → boxes
- brush → brushes

Past & Present Tense

Tense tells us when something happens.

Past (already happened):

Copy the word and add **-ed**.

- jump → jumped
- help → helped

Pronouns

Pronouns replace names.

- Sam → he
- Mia → she
- Sam and Mia → they
- The ball → it

Example: Sam was happy.
→ He was happy.

Contractions

Short forms of two words.

Rule: Remove a letter and add an apostrophe (').

He is → He's
They are → They're
It is → It's

Writing Tips

Drawing: Draw a picture that matches the title. Add details that help tell the story.

Past Tense: Use verbs that already happened (went, saw, ran).

Pronouns: Use We, He, She, They, or I.

Describing Words: Add words to show how things look, feel, or sound (brightly, cool, big, small, hot).

Extra Points: Use **exclamation (!)** or **question (?)** sentences. Wow! Do you like it too?
