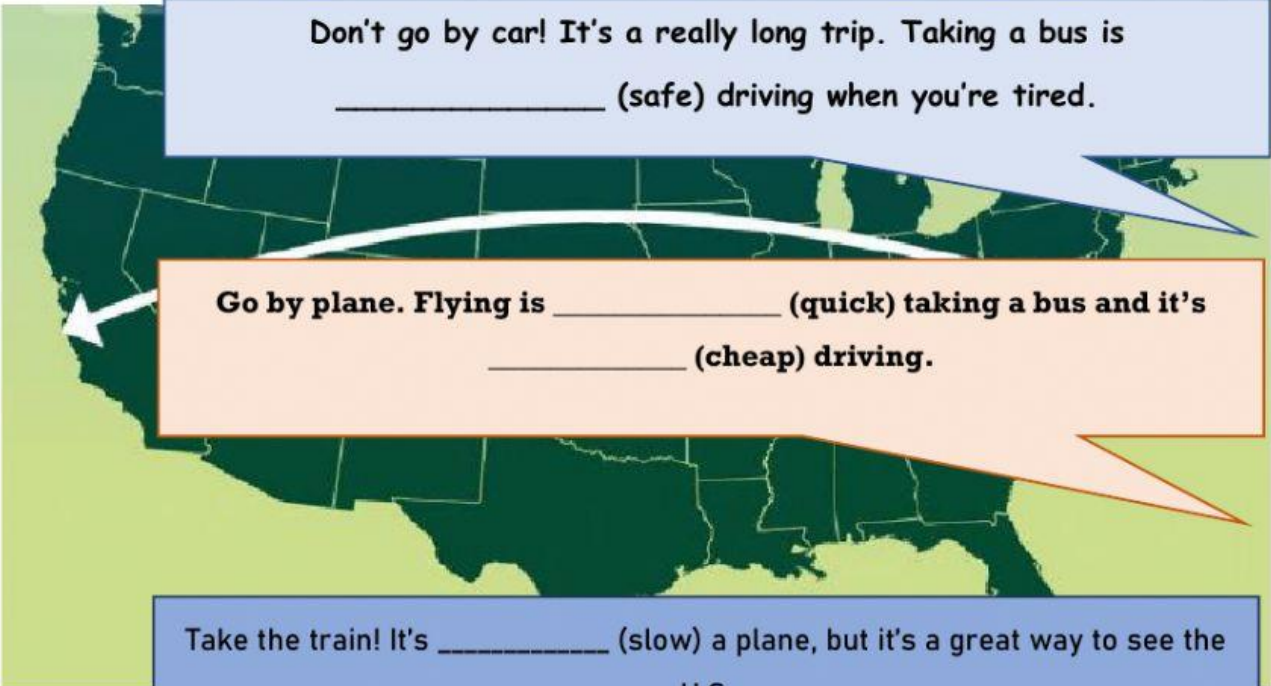


# Comparative adjectives
