Remember!

The **past tense** refers to events that happened and finished in the past.

1

For regular verbs, we add **-d**, **-ed** or **-ied**.

- Most verbs **+ed**
- play - **played**
- Verb ends in **-e**, we add only **(+d)**
- close - **closed**
- Verbs end in a consonant+y (we **drop** the **-y** and **add +ied**)
- study - **studied**
- When the verb has only one syllable and ends in **(CVC)** we (double the last consonant**+ed**)
- stop - **stopped**

For **irregular verbs**, there is a **special** past tense form.

- build - **built**
- eat - **ate**
- go - **went**



Be careful! 

When we use the **negative**, we don't change the main verb. We use 'didn't' instead.

- I **didn't** watch TV.
- I **didn't** go to school.




Examples!


