### Worksheet 3:

**Instructions:** Imagine you are writing a post for "Visit Abu Dhabi." Use the facts about Jebel Hafeet but use adverbs to show a high level of **Intentional Instruction** and precision.

**Prompt:** Write a 4-sentence review of the mountain.

- Include one adverb that modifies a **verb** (how someone acts).
- Include one adverb that modifies an **adjective** (the intensity of a feature).
- Include one adverb that modifies **another adverb** (how someone drives or speaks).

2. **The Redundancy Audit:** Examine the phrase "**very strongly**." In your notebook, list three single verbs that mean "to blow very strongly" (e.g., *galed, blustered, roared*).
3. **Synthesis:** Write a short paragraph about the **UAE Centennial 2071** goals. Use adverbs to describe how the nation will **progressively** and **successfully** achieve its aims. Highlight which adverbs modify other adverbs to show the highest level of grammatical mastery.
