Step 2: Write the Main Part (Past Simple) ★

Tell your friend **what you did** at the camp or event in Qatar.

- falcon show

- cultural festival
- festival

- ◆ **Example:** I went to a summer camp in the desert.
- ◆ We played traditional games.
- ◆ We watched a falcon show.

Step 3: Write Your Future Plans (Going to)

Tell your friend **what you are going to** do next summer.

- ◆ **Examples:** I am going to visit another camp.
- ◆ I am going to learn more about Qatari culture.
- ◆ I am going to go camping in the desert again.

Step 4: Write the Closing

Finish your email politely.

- ✓ I wrote a greeting.
