

Types of Discourse Markers:

Addition: These markers show that a new idea or information is being added to the previous one.

- *Additionally, moreover, furthermore, also, in addition.*

Contrast: These markers indicate a difference or opposition between two ideas.

- *However, on the other hand, but, nevertheless, although, whereas.*

Cause and Effect: They show a cause-and-effect relationship between ideas.

- *Therefore, thus, consequently, as a result, because.*

Emphasis: These markers emphasize a particular point or idea.

- *Indeed, in fact, especially, particularly, notably.*

Enumeration: They are used to list items or ideas.

- *Firstly, secondly, thirdly, in conclusion, to begin with.*
