such as *after, as soon as, before, till, until, when, whenever, while*

or time expressions such as *the minute, the moment* etc.

We do not use the future tense (will) in a time clause to describe

future activities. (in this respect, it is similar to if clauses).

As soon as you push this button the door will open.

Don't stand up till (until) I tell you.
