The earthquake in Turkey 2023



In February 2023 a powerful earthquake struck southern Turkey and northern Syria. It became one of the most destructive natural disasters in the region in many years. The earthquake happened early in the morning on February 6, when many people were still sleeping in their homes.

The earthquake had a magnitude of 7.8 and its epicenter was near the city of Kahramanmaraş. A few hours later another strong earthquake occurred in the same area. Because of these powerful shocks, thousands of buildings were destroyed or seriously damaged.

Many large cities such as Gaziantep, Antakya, and Adiyaman were badly affected. Roads, hospitals, schools, and houses were damaged. Millions of people lost electricity, water, and safe places to live.

Rescue teams worked day and night to save people trapped under the ruins. Many survivors were rescued several days after the disaster. Doctors, firefighters, soldiers, and volunteers helped the victims. International rescue teams were also sent from many countries.

Food, warm clothes, medicine, and tents were delivered to the affected areas. Temporary shelters were built for people who lost their homes. This disaster showed how important international help and cooperation are during difficult times.
