Why Some Animals Are Not Good Pets

Many children like unusual animals and want to keep them as pets, but these animals are not always suitable for home life. A porcupine is a wild mammal covered with sharp quills that it uses for protection. If it feels threatened, those quills can injure people or other animals. A pigeon may look harmless, but large numbers of pigeons can spread germs in cities.

Some animals also need special environments. A wombat, a marsupial from Australia, needs a large space to dig and move around. An iguana is a reptile that requires warm temperatures, UV light, and a balanced diet to stay healthy.

Other creatures can be harmful or unpleasant in a home. A piranha is a freshwater fish with very sharp teeth, so it must be kept in a secure aquarium. Small parasites such as fleas feed on the blood of animals and people, causing itching and discomfort. For these reasons, many families choose safer pets such as rabbits, dogs, or cats.
