1. There are two differences in the processes of attachment and entry into host cells among bacteriophages, non-enveloped viruses and enveloped viruses.

+ Attachment: Non-enveloped virus by; Enveloped virus by glycoprotein; Phage T4 by: tail fibers.

+ Penetration:

Enveloped virus: The virus enters the cell through between the plasma membrane and the viral envelope

Non - enveloped virus: The virus enters the cell by..... Then, host cell enzymes such as lysozyme the capsid and release the viral genome into the cytoplasm.

Phage: The tail fibers the enzyme lysozyme to break down the host cell wall. The tail sheath then contracts and injects the DNA into the cell, leaving the empty capsid outside.
