ALL ABOUT DOGS

There are wild dogs and pet dogs. Pet dogs are helpers and friends to people. There were no pet dogs 15,000 years ago. Men and women learned how to work with dogs. Dogs helped humans travel from Asia to



North America 10,000 years ago by pulling sleds in the snow. People say dogs are "man's best friend." Firstly, they help with farming. Secondly, they help with hunting and fishing. They can also pull things for people. Finally they can help find things and people.

There are many colors of dogs. They usually have dark earth-colored fur such as brown, grey, black and white. A dog's fur can be short, long and they can have curly or straight fur. Dog can be big or small ranging in size from only 6-8 inches tall all the way to 3 feet tall.

Some dogs can see well, but most don't. However all dogs can hear well. They can hear sounds that people cannot hear such as very high and low sounds. They can also hear things which are very far away. A dog's nose is very sensitive. They can smell 40 times better than humans! On average dogs live 5 to 13 years, but some dogs live much longer. One dog lived to be 24 years old!
