LIFE ON SPACE STATIONS

Space stations are places where astronauts work and study life in space. The largest space station is the International Space Station, which can hold six astronauts at a time. Astronauts often stay on space stations for long periods, with the record being 437 days. To survive, astronauts must be strong and healthy; as space life is very challenging.

Without gravity, things float in space. On Earth, an apple would fall when dropped, but in space, it would float. This **lack** of gravity makes it hard for astronauts to walk or stand normally, so they do special exercises daily to keep their legs strong.

Astronauts also face challenges with basic tasks like bathing. Since water cannot flow normally, they take baths instead of showers and use water carefully. Astronauts have to be extremely cautious because **they** have **limited** water supplies. It also cannot rain in space.

Living in space might be possible in the future, but it won't happen soon. Building space cities is very expensive, and only a few countries have the resources for it. Even if life in space became a reality, it would be very hard. Instead, we should focus on making life better on Earth.
