INGREDIENTS

- Tortillas (cut in quarters)
- 3 tomatoes
- A clove of garlic
- 1 onion
- 2 chillis
- 4 beef steaks
- Cheese and cream

RECIPE

- 0. **PUT / TOUCH** some oil in a pan and heat it up.
- 1. **ROAST / FRY** the tortillas in a little oil and then put them on a plate.
