It's Saturday night. **Normally**, when Katie is at work, she (1) \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ (wear) a red dress and black shoes.



Marlon **most often** (3) \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) sports clothes. But **tonight**,  
he looks like the famous detective Sherlock Holmes! He (4) \_\_\_\_\_  
(wear) a suit and the famous Sherlock Holmes hat. And he (5)  
\_\_\_\_\_ (smoke) a pipe!

Louise **usually** (6) \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) smart business suits, but **tonight**  
she looks very different. She (7) \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) a long white dress  
and a strange hat. She looks like the Statue of Liberty.



**When Sam is at work**, he (8) \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) a shirt and tie, and he **always**  
looks smart. **Tonight** he (9) \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) a spaceman costume! He  
looks amazing.

Why are they wearing these clothes? They (10) \_\_\_\_\_ (go) to a fancy-dress party  
for their friend Suzie's birthday! Suzie wants everyone to dress up as someone or something  
that starts with the letter "S."
