Mark	Name	Example in Dialogue
.	Period	"I like school," she said.
,	Comma	She said, "I like school."
?	Question Mark	"Where are you going?" he asked.
!	Exclamation Mark	"Watch out!" the boy yelled.
" "	Quotation Marks	"Always used around spoken words."
