

Coffee beans, which grow on a plant, are actually cherry seeds. The coffee plant produces small multicoloured cherries, which have seeds known as a 'peaberry', and that is where the beans are harvested from.

Coffee bean plants can take up to one year to grow, and then it will take roughly another five years before any fruit is produced. To maintain the height of these plants, they are regularly pruned (dead or overgrown branches are trimmed away). However, if left untrimmed, they can grow very high.
