## Passive/Reported Speech/ Indirect question

### Note:

- Điểm giống giữa Cách viết Reported speech của một câu hỏi và Indirect question: chúng ta **KHÔNG đảo ngữ** như các câu hỏi bình thường mà để cấu trúc như 1 câu (S +V/be+O...)
- Khác nhau: **Indirect question** sẽ sử dụng các cụm như
  - *I wonder...*
  - *Can you tell me...*
  - *Do you know...*

Sau đó mới đến các từ để hỏi, **thì sẽ giữ nguyên**; trong khi với **Reported question**, chúng ta cần phải **lùi thì** tương ứng

Khi viết câu **bị động** với các từ có **2 Objects**, chú ý khi dùng **OFFER**. thường chỉ có câu bị động với **O chỉ người**.. Ngoài ra, offer **to** someone
