You searched for three jobs. Here are the best results:

Tour Guide:

Pluses: Many tour guides ³*get / are* self-employed, so they can't ⁴*get / have* the sack. It's also easy to ⁵*take / do* days off when you choose, because you run your own company.

Minuses: Most tour guides ⁶*are / have* badly-paid. Because they ⁷*do / work* outdoors, tour guides often only have a ⁸*full-time job / part-time job* when the weather is not very good. In the summer, however, when there are lots of tourists, you can expect to work ⁹*nights shifts / long hours* every day.

Doctor:

Pluses: Experienced doctors are generally pretty ¹⁰*well-paid / badly-paid*. They can take between 20 and 30 days ¹¹*overtime / paid holiday* per year.

Minuses: Training is long and expensive. Junior doctors usually work ¹²*long hours / a job* which also often involves doing ¹³*night shifts / overtime* one day per week.

Office Manager:

Pluses: Office managers have a ¹⁴*part-time job / full-time job* and like other employees they ¹⁵*have / do* four weeks' paid holiday per year.

Minuses: Office managers rarely travel in their jobs and often have to work ¹⁶*overtime / indoors* after their regular 8-hour day. They are usually ¹⁷*responsible / fired* for keeping an office problem-free, so it can be very stressful work when things go wrong.
